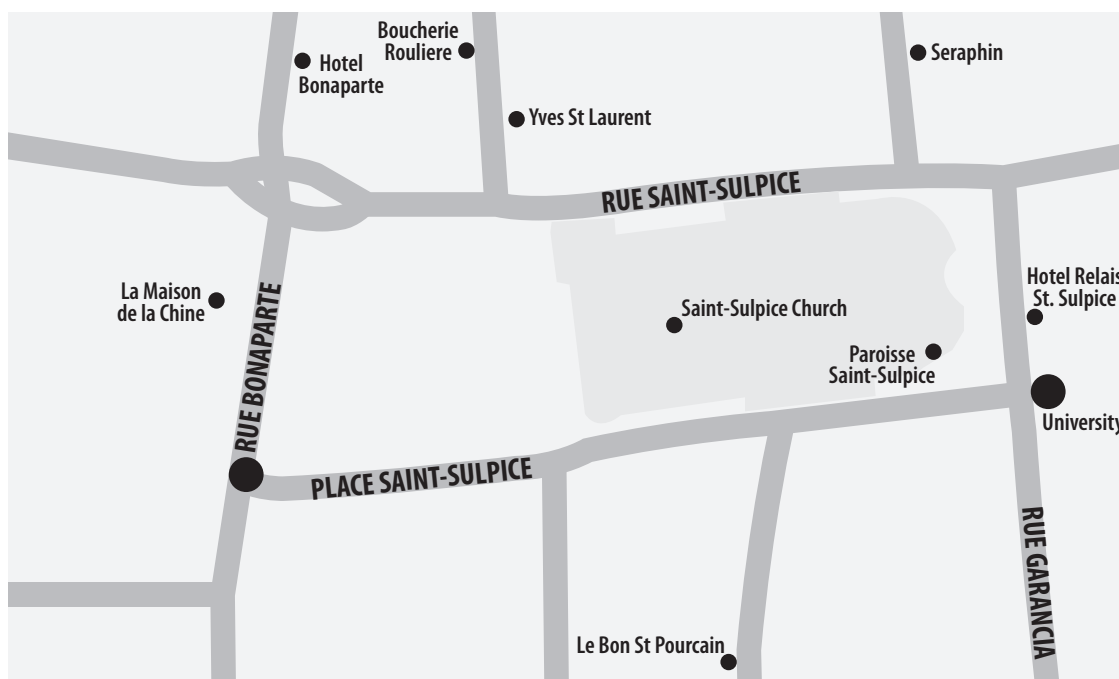

Seven years elapsed before it was first presented to Wilfred Cohen in 1991.
